
AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION - FIREFIGHTERS AT WORK

Divide the audience into six groups. Assign each group a part; the entire group plays the "crowd"

<u>FIRE TRUCK</u> -	Make a siren sound	<u>POLICE OFFICERS</u> -	Whistle
<u>WATER HOSE</u> -	SSHHSSHHH (water sound)	<u>FIREFIGHTERS</u> -	"To the rescue"
<u>WOMAN</u> -	"Save me, save me!"	<u>FIRE</u> -	"Crackle, boom, boom"
<u>CROWD</u> -	"Ah-h-h-h!"		

Once upon a time there was a bright red **FIRE TRUCK** with a brand new **WATER HOSE**, and to ride on the **FIRE TRUCK** there were plenty of smartly dressed **FIREFIGHTERS**. The job of the **FIREFIGHTERS** and the **FIRE TRUCK** and the **WATER HOSE** was to put out **FIRES**. To put out **FIRES**, the **FIREFIGHTERS** had practiced for weeks using the **FIRE TRUCK** and the **WATER HOSE**.
