- **Saturday January 28, 2006**

Things for Troop to do before the Klondike:

- **Homemade Snow Snakes** - Prior to Klondike, each Patrol needs to design, make and decorate a snow snake; length 6 to 7 feet and 2 inches tall by 2 inches high. Enter the competition to win for distance and design. (*Design – Materials Sheet Attached.)
- **Troop Sled** – Build, rebuild, and update the sled. Good patrol activity to work on the sled and learn new skills. (*Design – Materials Sheet Attached.)

Klondike is the oldest Scouting Camporee Event, and is some 90 years old. It was the first event where Troops would meet for a Council competition. Klondike is an all day event with round robin activities to keep you warm.

Items for Each Patrol to Bring for Activity Stations:

1. Firewood
 2. Coffee Can
 3. Water Supply for Boiling
 4. Tarp (*minimum size: 8 X 8) for a shelter-building contest.
- **Please Note:** Patrols need to furnish their own lunch and water while on the trails between event stations.

NO Tennis Shoes. Any scout wearing tennis shoes will be sent home immediately. Dress in layers for changing events, and remember that you can haul extra clothes in your sleds. There will be awards and patches for those who participate.

Safety comes first in all Scouting events. The first line of defense in winter first aid is correct clothing and an adequate food supply.
