Younger, less experienced scouts will partake in the station events taught by the more experienced scouts from their unit and other units. Everyone will have an opportunity to participate in “Know it • Do it • Teach it”. Scoring the camporee will be based on how well the station is taught.

Advance registration will be required by September 21. We will need the number of youth and adults attending from each unit for campsite assigning purposes, and to aid in on site registration. Please send bring your funds with you to the camporee, don't send them to the Scout Office.

Units may combine with other units to develop and present their station area.

One adult leader will be required at the station at all times.

Unit which does the American Flag Etiquette station should plan on providing two sets of scouts in class A uniform to raise and lower flags.

Unit which does the Campfire Entertainment station should plan on presenting the Camporee campfire and to provide two MC's for the campfire.

We will also need volunteers to set up and extinguish the campfire, and to act as Chaplain's Aides.
