April 19th BALOO – Rum River Scout Camp - 7:30 am to 4pm
(Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation) is a course designed to teach adults how to plan and execute an outdoor activity for Cub Scout groups. It is the entry level introductory outdoor training of the Boy Scouts of America. In order for a Cub Scout Pack to go camping, it must have a BALOO trained leader in charge of and present at the activity. Fee is \$15.00. Lunch & snack will be provided.

April 19th BALOO & OWLS – Rum River Camp – 7:30 am Sat. to 12:00 pm Sun.
To (Outdoor Webelos Leader Skills) is for Webelos leaders & Bear leaders who are transitioning to Webelos leaders. This course completes the training award requirements for Webelos leaders. Participants will learn how to use the outdoor program to help their Webelos earn the outdoor activity pins. Participants will cook outdoor meals, plan Webelos overnight camping and experience a campfire. Attendees will need to bring their overnight camping gear; tent, sleeping bag. Cooking equipment will be provided. Fee is \$20.00. Lunch, snack, dinner & breakfast is provided. **The information covered in the morning session of the OWLS training will qualify you as BALOO trained.**
