Northern Lights District Cub Activity Days

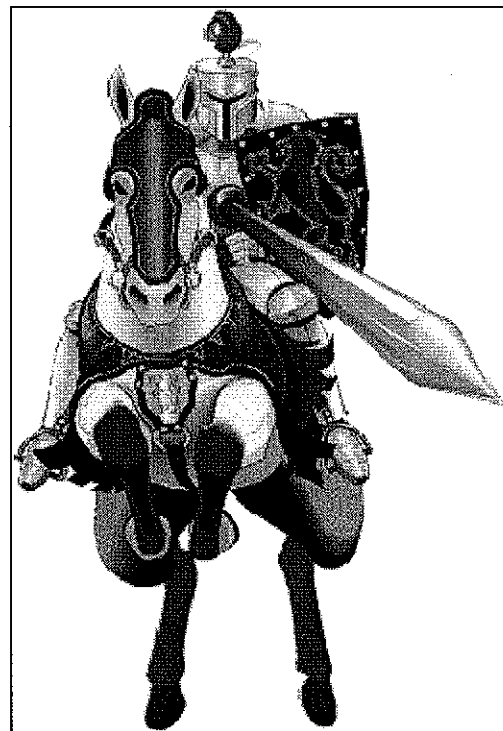

WHO: Any boy entering grades 1-5 in the fall and their escorts

WHERE: RUM RIVER SCOUT CAMP

COST: If paid by July 15th, the youth fee is \$20 per camp. Fee provides for a T-shirt, water bottle, patch, crafts, and programs. The fee increase is an additional \$5 after July 16th-July 31st.

Final registration is Thursday July 31st. No REGISTRATION IS ACCEPTED AFTER THIS DATE Adults are always FREE.

TIME: Check-in begins at 8:15 a.m., program starts at 9:00 a.m. SHARP, and ends at 4:00 p.m.

ACTIVITIES: Archery & BB guns, Scout style advancement, crafts, games, sports, and FUN, FUN, FUN!!!!
