Registration

Deadline to submit troop registration forms is February 13th.

Note: Scout uniform is preferred at all locations.

Troops Need to Bring

Each unit is required to provide 1-2 adult leaders whom can attend a MB of their choice (or may be assigned). This will help maintain 2-deep leadership as well as provide support for the MB counselors.

Note: Scouts will be responsible for any pre-requisites for their badges, otherwise ‘partials’ will be noted on the merit badge cards. Counselors will arrange additional meeting times with scouts if needed to complete remaining MB requirements.
