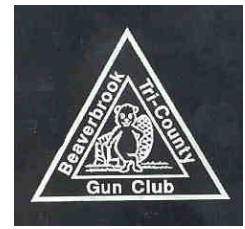




# BSA Rifle Merit Badge

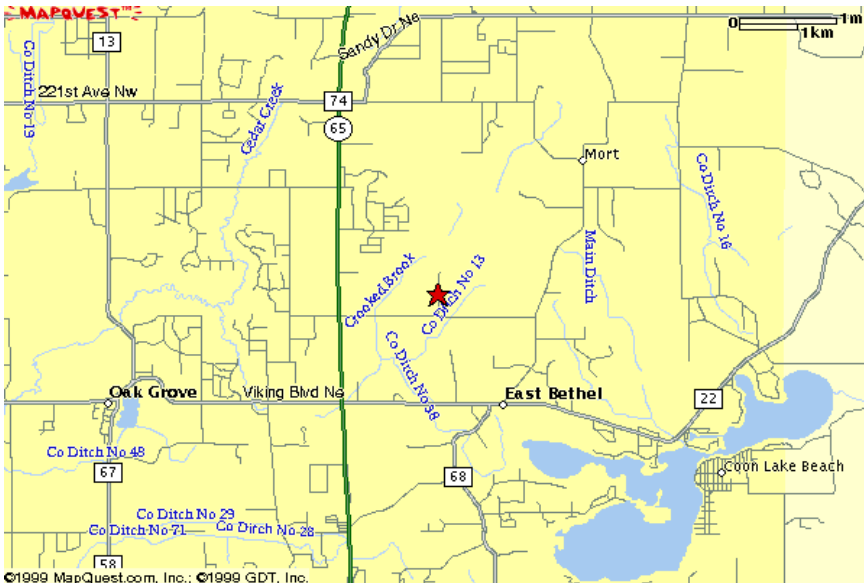

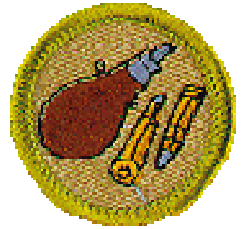
Beaverbrook Tri-County Gun Club and Ten Ring are offering the Rifle Merit Badge to Scouts May 9, 2009. We are presenting the complete Merit Badge start to finish. Partial merit Badge Scouts are welcome. The class will be presented by Ten Ring BSA personnel holding NRA, DNR, BSA Merit Badge and other firearms instructor ratings and credentials.

We will be working in Patrols of six Scouts. Each patrol will start with about 2 hours in class and then move to the range for 2 hours of shooting. You will also have the opportunity to shoot a black powder rifle and may earn the Merit Badge with it. Please do not bring firearms or ammunition. Please dress for the range and be prepared for Minnesota weather.

The class, lunch and range expenses are donated by the sponsors. A voluntary donation of \$3 to help cover costs is suggested. Donation of a food item for the local food shelf will be gratefully appreciated. Remember you will need a Rifle Merit Badge book and your Merit Badge card signed by your Scoutmaster. Please read your Merit Badge book before class so you can participate right away. Bring your permission slip to the class.
