Registration

<u>Step 1:</u> Units review MB worksheet for badge offerings, locations, pre-requisites and cost information. Fill out registration form(s) with scout and leader information along with all <u>three</u> MB choices. <u>Step 2:</u> Bring completed registration form(s) to February Round Table or Scout Office before Friday 2/12/10 at 5 p.m. **Step3:** Units will be notified week of 3/1/10 of MB choices.

Deadline to submit troop registration forms is February 12th.

Registrations will be on a first come first served basis. Requests from non- Northern Lights Units will be filled after February 12th.

Note: Scout uniform is required at all locations.

Troops Need to Bring

Each unit is required to provide 2 adult leaders whom can attend a MB of their choice (or may be assigned). This will help maintain 2-deep leadership as well as provide support for the MB counselors.

<u>Note:</u> Scouts will be responsible for any pre-requisites for their badges as listed, 'partials' will be noted on the merit badge cards. Counselors will arrange additional meeting times with scouts if needed to complete remaining MB requirements.
