## 2011 - Boy Scout Merit Badge Classes

Ten Ring along with Rapids Archery Club and Beaverbrook Sportsmen's Club are offering Scouts the opportunity to earn these shooting sports merit badges. We present the complete Merit Badge start to finish and each Scout will complete it all in one day. If a Scout already has a partial Merit Badge no problem just let us know what sections you need to complete. Over the past years Ten Ring has had a 100% completion rate with these merit badge classes. We will have Merit Badge Counselors there to help with every aspect of the class. Everything you need will be provided, the Scout only needs to have a merit badge book and card signed by their Scoutmaster, we will supply the rest. To assure that every Scout finishes the merit badge we have developed a workbook for each class. So before coming to the class please read your Merit Badge book and have your workbook completed so you can participate right away.

Ten Ring will give any Scout the opportunity to earn these merit badges. A voluntary donation of \$6.00 per merit badge to help cover costs would be nice but is not required. As good Scouts please remember to "Do a Good Turn Daily" a donation of a food item for the local food shelf will be gratefully appreciated.



### BSA Archery Merit Badge

*Jan 16<sup>th</sup> & 23<sup>rd</sup> and Feb 13<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup>*

Ten Ring will be offering the Archery Merit Badge this winter during four separate classes. Don't worry we're inside a nice warm indoor

archery range. We are prepared to guide you through all of the Archery requirements from helping with the making of the arrow and the bowstring to making sure you shoot your best. Everything you need will be provided including lunch. We have space for 24 Scouts per day, we start at 8:00AM and usually finish before 2:00 PM.



### BSA Rifle Merit Badge

*May 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup>*

The Rifle Merit Badge this May will be offered on two days with six separate classes each day. Each class is a patrol of eight scouts. Each patrol

will start with the classroom portion and then move to the range for the target shooting. The starting time of each patrol is listed below and the class takes about three hours. Before coming to the class a completed workbook is required. Please do not bring any firearms or ammunition we will provide everything including snacks. Remember to dress for the outdoor range and be prepared for Minnesota weather. For the Rifle Merit Badge we MUST have a signed permission slip to participate in the class.

(Note: The Orange card patrol is for those scouts that have their DNR firearms safety card or those scouts that only need to finish the shooting portion of the merit badge)
