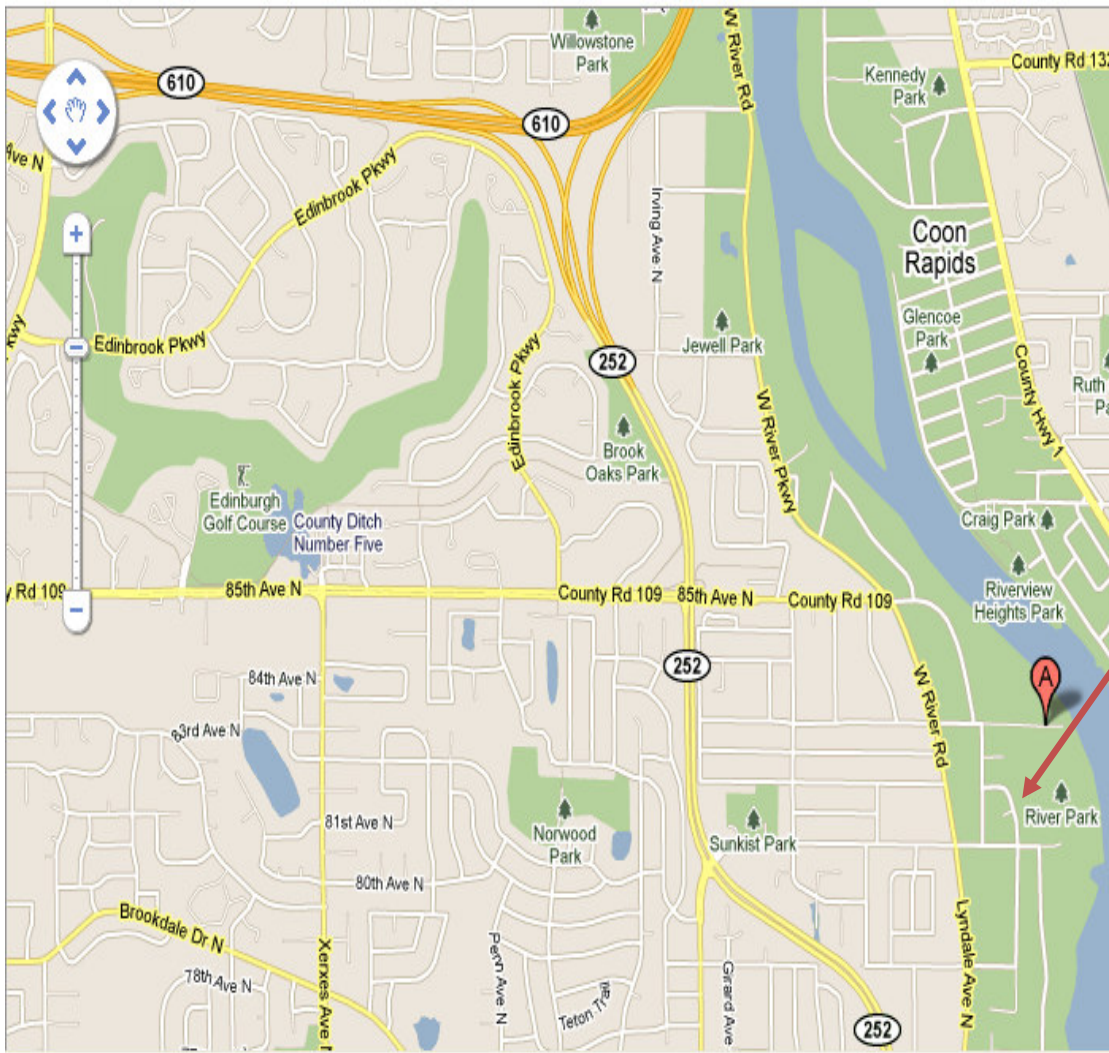


Northern Lights District Cub Scout Picnic And Cubannapolis Races

Cub Annapolis Rules

Each scout should make his own cardboard box car that he wears. He can decorate it as he wishes -- family members are allowed to help.

Each team is composed of: **The "Driver" (Cub Scout)**
 The "Pit Crew" (2 or 3 or more family members)

The driver must wear a pair of lace-up shoes with socks. NO SLIP ON SHOES! They must Tie!

Each heat consists of 4 laps, and each driver must make 3 pit stops during the first 3 laps. During the pit stop, the crew must do one of the following:

- Change tires (remove shoes, turn socks inside out, replace and retie shoes)
- **Refuel (driver drinks four ounces of liquid through a straw)**
- **Clean windshield (wash face with wet washcloth)**

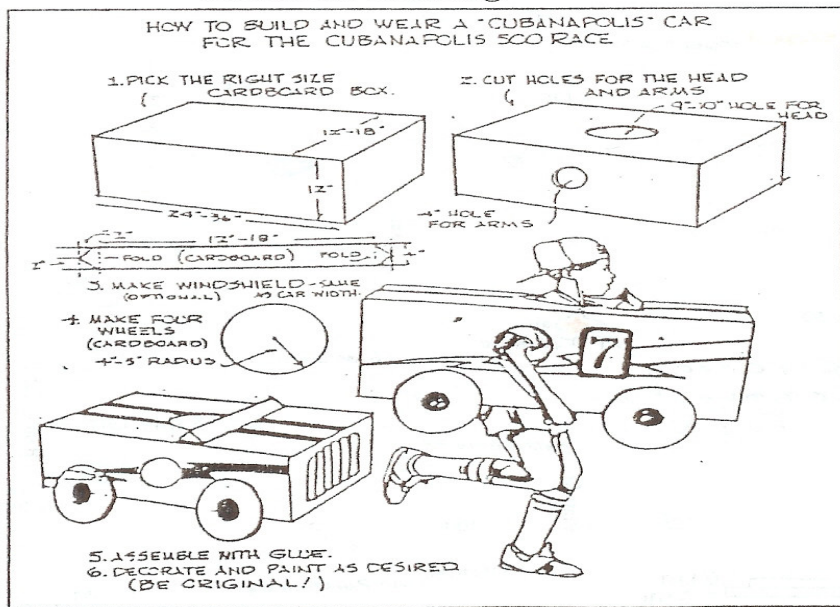
At the end of the race, all three of the above should have been done by the crew. There is no pre-determined order as to which should or must be done first.

THE SCOUT SHOULD BRING:

- **Cardboard Cubannapolis car**
- **One washcloth**
- **Tie shoes and socks**
- **Repair supplies (tape, stapler, etc)**
- **A Hard Working Pit Crew!!**

DISTRICT WILL FURNISH:

- **Refueling liquid (kool-aid or lemonade)**
- **Straws for refueling**
