

## **Webelos Experience 2011**

### *Frequently Asked Questions*

**1. What will be available for activities?**

In addition to an overnight campout, your Webelos Scouts will also be able to play great outdoor games and participate in activities with items like cool cars, camping equipment and more. Also, depending on age, your Webelos can work on activity pins or attend an area where the events are taken to the next level of Boy Scouting. Check out Facebook for more detail.

**2. What is the ratio of adults to Scouts?**

One Adult to One Scout

**3. Will we need to bring our own camping equipment?**

Yes, your Pack will need all of their own equipment: tents, cooking gear, food etc. Also Each person will need their own personal gear.

**4. If we don't have camping equipment what are our options?**

Contact a Troop in your area to see if your Pack can borrow the necessary equipment.

**5. Will we need to provide our own food?**

Yes, your Pack will need to provide their food for all three meals (Sat: Lunch & Supper, Sun: Breakfast).

**6. What is the schedule?**

Check in begins after 7:30am on Saturday and activities continue until 9:00am on Sunday morning.

**7. Will all of the requirements for the activity pins be covered?**

Not all of the requirements of each pin will be covered. However, this is an excellent opportunity to expose your Webelos to the pins and note which ones are of interest to your Webelos for future Den meetings.

**8. Could we just stay on Saturday during the day and leave in the evening?**

This is a Saturday and Sunday event with an overnight campout.

**9. Can I have a ground fire?**

Sorry, for the safety of all in attendance we are not able to allow ground fires or charcoal due to the volume of people at the event.

**10. Should I carpool?**

Yes, plan on carpooling with the rest of your Pack. Yet, you should try to pack all gear in one vehicle per Pack.

**11. What recognition items will participants receive?**

All registered participants will receive a Webelos Experience patch and can work toward a participation pin after completion of all of the activities.

**12. Can we leave on Saturday evening?**

To get the full extent of this great program we have structured the event as an overnight camp out. If a unit leaves on Saturday evening for a religious or other reason leaders should know that gear will need to be hiked out to parking lots as roads will not reopen until Sunday morning.
