## **What is Webelos Experience?**

Webelos Experience is a 'can't miss' Council super event that occurs only every other year for Webelos and their families. This two-day camping event promises to keep your Webelos engaged and excited to continue in the Scouting program.

## **What will happen at Webelos Experience?**

During Saturday morning and afternoon, Webelos will travel among three different activity areas.

The Games area includes cool field games like jousting and 3-legged soccer. The See & Do Midway includes exhibits like RC helicopters, blacksmithing, actual race cars and more. The Activity Pin area features the possibility of earning requirements towards actual pins for First Year Webelos. Second Year Webelos will investigate the activities and equipment of Boy Scouting in the Transition area.

Saturday evening includes a complete outdoor stage show with a live band and a tremendous fireworks display. The evening ends with your Den camping out overnight in your own tents.
