Ad Altare Dei Emblem Retreat

The Ad Altare Dei emblem program is offered through the National Catholic Committee on Scouting (NCCS).

Each diocese has a Catholic Committee on Scouting which oversees the emblem programs for all scouts; Cub, Boy, Venture, Girl and American Heritage Girls.

Eligibility for Ad Altare Dei Emblem

- ✚ Must be a registered Boy Scout of Catholic faith.
- ✚ Has been baptized in the Catholic faith.
- ✚ Has been an active member of his Troop /Crew for 6 months.
- ✚ Must be 13 or 14 years old or has completed 6th grade. [older scouts may use this program but cannot be 18 or older].

ENCOURAGED:

- ✚ Must practice their faith through Faith Formation or Religious Education within parish and attend Mass regularly with at least one parent.

The Ad Altare Dei Emblem Retreat is a two weekend retreat. **Scouts must be able to commit to both weekends to attend.**

The retreat will be held:

- **1st weekend**
November 9-11, 2012
- **2nd weekend**
January 11-13, 2013

The AAD emblem program covers the seven sacraments and a scout's relationship with God and Scouting.

Over the two weekends the scout will explore each sacrament.

Each scout is expected to purchase their own Ad Altare Dei workbook

Cost: around \$5.00

In the front of the workbook there is a form in which **a scout must obtain five signatures.** He *must obtain four* of the five before coming to the retreat:

- Scout's signature
- Parents signature
- Scoutmaster's signature
- Pastor's signature
- **Scout will get Counselor signature at the retreat.*

Between the two weekends scouts will have several service projects they will need to complete before returning for 2nd weekend.

Mass will be part of both weekends.

On Saturday evening and Sunday morning of the 2nd weekend each scout will attend a Board of Review.

The scout will be presented his emblem, with all Boy & Girl Scouts, who have earned their emblems at a Mass in April of 2013 at St. Mary's Basilica in Minneapolis.
