### **Class Information: "YOU'VE BEEN EDGED"**

### **TIER I (Tarzan) – Scout to 2<sup>nd</sup> Class**

Understand the basics of Scouting and how each Scout fits into the overall structure.

#### Session I

"Finding the Vines"

- Learn the ropes of Scouting and what Scouting has to offer.
- Discuss the Troop structure and how everyone works together to reach a goal.

#### Session II

"Swinging Together"

- Work as a team to solve problems.
- Learn some basic Scout skills while also building leadership skills.

#### Session III

"Treetops and Skyward"

- Build a pioneering project guided by the senior youth
- Learn by **DOING** and interact with more experienced Scouts.
- Have FUN!

### **TIER II (Fargo Flood) – 1<sup>st</sup> class to Star**

Demonstrate your Skill and experience the challenges of being a leader.

#### Session I

"Fargo Flood Fiasco"

- Work as a team in a challenging activity.
- Discuss/reflect on the overall success of the group, and identify areas for improvement.

#### Session II

"PLC – Tools for Success"

- Learn more effective ways of managing your group by participating in a PLC exercise.
- Learn the keys to success in planning.
- Practice problem solving and conflict resolution.

#### Session III

"Crossing the Great Divide"

- Plan and carry out a more challenging pioneering project.
- Discuss/reflect on the overall success, and identify areas for improvement.
- Have FUN!

### **TIER III (Top Gun) – Life & Eagle**

Guide and Enable others, using the skills you have learned to teach Tier I.

#### Session I

"Brain Laps"

- Exercise your mind by completing challenging team-oriented games.
- Learn what **YOU** can do when you **RUN** out of ideas for Troop or Patrol programming.

#### Session II

"On EDGE..."

- Learn the basics of teaching using the EDGE format.
- Work as a Training Patrol to plan an activity.

#### Session III

"Mission ~~Im~~Possible"

- Carry out that planned activity, teaching valuable skills to newer Scouts (Tier I) and modeling good leadership by setting a strong example.
- Have FUN!
