

## **JTE 2013 Changes**

Some changes were made across all unit types:

- Dates were changed throughout to reflect the 2013 year.
- Note that activity plan information needs to be entered in the Unit (Online) Toolbox.

### ***District***

- District #4 "Popcorn sales" becomes "product sales". The Bronze criteria was changed to accept meeting the overall finance goal (the same change that was made late in the 2012 JTE program).
- District #9 "Roundtable": New for 2013
- District #10 "Nominating Committee & District Leadership": Combination of 2012 "#9: District leadership" and "#10: Nominating committee" objectives.

### ***Pack***

- Pack #2 "Retention": Changed to use standard National Council data and retention calculation.
- Pack #3 "Building Better Scouting": Combination of 2012 #3 "Building Cub Scouting" with 2012 #8 "Webelos to Scout Transition"
- Pack #8 "Roundtable": New for 2013
- Pack #10: Addition of silver level for on-time 2014 recharter.

### ***Troop***

- Troop #2 "Retention": Changed to use standard National Council data and retention calculation.
- Troop #3 "Building Better Scouting": Combination of 2012 #3 "Building Boy Scouting" with 2012 #8 "Webelos to Scout Transition"
- Troop #8 "Roundtable": New for 2013
- Troop #10: Addition of silver level for on-time 2014 recharter.

### ***Team***

- In 2012, the troop objectives were used for teams as well, but that wasn't a good fit due to differences between the programs. For 2013, teams have their own objectives that match the Varsity Scout program. The differences noted below are from the 2012 troop objectives.
- Team #2 "Retention": Changed to use standard National Council data and retention calculation.
- Team #3 "Building Better Scouting": Combination of 2012 #3 "Building Boy Scouting" with 2012 #8 "Webelos to Scout Transition". The transition is troop/Boy Scout to team/Varsity Scout rather than Webelos to Boy Scout.
- Team #4 "Trained Leadership": Adjusted to reflect team leadership positions and training requirements
- Team #5 "Five fields of emphasis": Replaces short-term campouts as a more appropriate objective for the Varsity Scout program.
- Team #8 "Roundtable": New for 2013
- Team #10: Addition of silver level for on-time 2014 recharter.

## **Crew**

- Order of objectives was changed to more closely correspond with that of other unit types.
- Crew #1 "Youth Leadership": Changed Bronze level to require crew participation in ILSC.
- Crew #2 "Retention": Changed to use standard National Council data and retention calculation.
- Crew #4 "Trained Leadership": Changed Youth Protection training to be Venturing version. Changed Bronze, Silver, and Gold requirements to be more in line with other unit types.
- Crew #8 "Roundtable": New for 2013

## **Ship**

- In 2012, the crew objectives were used for ships as well, but that wasn't a good fit due to differences between the programs. For 2013, ships have their own objectives that match the Sea Scout program. The differences noted below are from the 2012 crew objectives.
