

# Webelos Experience Stearns Scout Camp October 5-6, 2013

## Frequently Asked Questions

### **What is Webelos Experience?**

Webelos Experience is for 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade boys, all 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year Webelos. This overnight campout will be the highlight of your Cub Scout career! Activities will include **GAMES** (Blanket Volleyball, Jolly Ball, Joust), **EXHIBITS** (Rockets, Wood Carving, Blacksmith), **ACTIVITY BADGES** (Geologist, Handyman, Engineer), **WEBELOS TRANSITION** (Cooking, Eagle Trail, Pioneering) and much more! Additional games, exhibits, activity badges and Webelos Transition activities can be found in the Leaders Guide.

### **When and how can we register?**

Registration opens online on August 15<sup>th</sup>. There will be a link to the registration at:

Registration is \$18 per youth and \$18 per adult. Please plan to register by September 23<sup>rd</sup> so any materials can be mailed out. Registrations made after that date will have to be processed at the Golden Valley office, 5300 Glenwood Ave. to receive Vehicle Equipment passes. Leader's Guide will be posted on the registration site along with Health forms.

### **Where is the Leaders Guide?**

The Leaders Guide will help you and your unit properly prepare for the event. Leaders Guides will be available on the web, <http://www.northernstarbsa.org/ActivitiesCivicService/Local/WebelosExperience.aspx>, on August 15.

### **Are parents welcome?**

Parents must attend with their child. They will attend all the activities with their child during the event.

### **What do we need to bring?**

Each unit is responsible for bring their own tents, ground pads, food, eating and cooking utensils, trash bags. Plan for both warm and cold weather and pack accordingly. Meals should be simple and easy to prepare. All cooking must be done on propane or liquid fuel stoves. No charcoal or fires will be allowed. Picnic tables will not be provided.

### **When can we arrive?**

Gates will open at 7:30am on Saturday. Carpooling is essential as parking is limited. Park in designated areas only. You will be assigned a Sub-Camp and Parking Lot after registering according to your District. All vehicles will need a Parking Pass to enter a parking lot. ONE vehicle per unit will be issued a VEHICLE EQUIPMENT PASS. This will allow one vehicle to enter camp, drop equipment at your assigned camp and immediately return your vehicle to your assigned parking lot. No vehicle travel is permitted (except Emergency Vehicles, Staff or Public Safety vehicles) once programs begin. This is for the safety of you and your Webelos! Programs start at 10:00am.

### **What time is Webelos Experience over on Sunday?**

Check out begins at 9:00am Sunday, after Worship services. Only vehicles with a VEHICLE EQUIPMENT PASS will be allowed into camp to pick up equipment. No other cars are permitted into camp.

### **Will there be a trading post?**

Yes, Trading Posts will have limited supplies of gifts, snacks, etc. Small bills and checks accepted only. An online order form for Custom T-shirts will be available in your Leader's Guide.

### **Are uniforms required?**

This is a uniformed activity for all registered youth and adults. Uniforms should be worn during travel, shows and worship services. An activity uniform is fine for youth during the general program time.
