For one week only, Many Point will again be offering its All Things Aquatic Advancement and Adventure week. This is NOT a typical week with the troop or crew. This program is entirely focused on water-based adventures. Space is limited to 16 participants, so sign up early!

Similar to the All-Star program, Scouts and Venturers can sign up as individuals, and we will provide staff to serve as the adult leadership within a site, or Scouts can return to their unit's campsite at night.

The All Things Aquatic fee is \$285 for the week, which includes all meals, equipment and program. The fee does not include transportation. Participants will receive a special recognition patch only available by participating in this program. Return this registration form with \$25 per participant to reserve your spot. The balance will be due by June 1. The program requires a minimum of 7 participants. If the minimum is not met, all fees paid will be refunded.
