We are changing our processes to better serve YOU!

The NRA Instructor classes require a candidate to pass a Pre-Course Qualification for each instructor rating. The qualification for modern firearms consists of a basic knowledge test, loading - unloading, clearing common stoppages and shooting. These qualifying requirements can be found on our training page. Each will take several hours. The Muzzleloading Rifle Instructor class will have its own refresher training and qualification day on August 10th.

There are no deposits. There are no costs for the Pre-Course Qualification except the Shotgun Instructor candidates will pay for clay targets and bring or buy shotgun-shells. After qualifying, a candidate must attend the Basic Instructor Training which is the second part of August 2nd. Payment is expected at this time. Then the candidate will complete the selected Basic Instructor class(es). Note, these classes will have a cap on the number of attendees. We are scheduled to finish each course in a day. Instructor course length runs from ten (10) to fourteen (14) hours. Some days will be long but we will try to finish on that day.
