What we need done:

- Prairie grass seed collection and distribution.
- Collecting burdock seed heads
- Collecting seedheads from goldenrods.
- Removal of trash from people who visit the site.



Dates- Every Sunday from 2-6 pm (Weather Permitting)
For all of October.

- Prairie and grass collection: October 12, and 19
- Collecting burdock seed heads: Any weekend
- Collecting Seed heads from goldenrod: October 5, and 12

Location- The north end of Pilot Knob Road. Enter through the gate next to Acacia Cemetery.

Extra Information: You will not need any extra equipment but You may want to bring work gloves and a water bottle. If you have hand trimmers please bring those. Service hours count towards the Centennial award.

We will gather at the parking lot at the entrance to the prairie and go onto the site together. This is a controlled site, so we will perform service under the supervision of the site steward. The Pilot Knob site is a Dakota holy place. Please be respectful of the property so we are welcomed back!
