*Camporee is a learning experience to expand a Scouts life-skills growth with hands-on activities.*

Camporee will have six events that will introduce the Scout to how things work, challenge his abilities and bring home good memories. Webelos are invited to participate in the event as a guest of a troop.

### There will be three Main Events:

#### **Wind Power Tech**

Scouts will build their own windmill that is functional and can be used at home. Learn about wind power turbines and energy.  
**Help build a full-size windmill!**

#### **History: Civil War Cannon Detail**

The Minnesota 1<sup>st</sup> Regiment Cannon Detail 1862 brings to life the experiences of soldiers during the Civil War 150 years ago.

#### **Scouting Skills**

This will be demonstration of basic lashings and knots. This will help build the teamwork and skills needed to construct the full-size windmill.

### What to Do — What to Bring

Scouts will participate in groups that have between 8 and 18 youth. Troops with more than 18 Scouts attending will be split into one (or more) groups. Life and Eagle Scouts are encouraged to volunteer to help lead the break-out sessions.

Troops will need to furnish support items to help the event run smoothly for the Scouts.
