




Northern Lights District

Going back to a time when heavy metal was king in America and steel was strength: This camporee will be all about working with metallurgy science — a STEM program — to introduce the Scouts to the art of metals.

Scouts will work a small foundry to cast little Viking ships and other objects. They will also make a tin can lantern, and skill challenges will include 2-minute fire building and how to cook over a wood fire with a pot and S-hook. Everyone will receive their own Hëavy Mëtals Camporee Patch. (Pre-register by April 21st to guarantee a patch, otherwise while-supplies-last.)
